#### **Community Strengthening**

Wyndham CEC began to provide community strengthening services in early 2010, to respond to emerging community needs.

- Funded by the Department of Social Services to provide settlement services to permanent residents who have arrived in Australia in the last five years as humanitarian entrants or family stream migrants with low English proficiency.
- Services are designed to enable clients to become independent and actively participate in Australian society as soon as possible.
- We also assist eligible communities that need assistance and support to develop capacity to meet the needs of their members.


